An easy drinking white wine from southern France. Fresh, light and soft with hints of citrus and apricot.		
2 2009 Handmade White, Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa	4.75	18.95
Bursting with passion fruit and kiwis with zippy acidity, you cant get a better fish washer downer.		
3 2008 Pinot Grigio, Ancorra, Italy	4.25	15.50
Bobbing for lemons, crisp & zingy. Very light and clean, slips down a treat.		
4 2008 Domaine verdilhan, Viognier, France	4.25	15.50
Mellow style of white.		
5 2008 Muscadet de Sevre Maine sur lie, Menard-Gaborit, France		16.25
A classic style of Muscadet, flinty, zippy, crisp, dry, intense with a fresh, mineral stoney finish.		
6 2006 Chardonnay del Friuli, Fabio Coser, Friuli, Italy		17.95
A very fine Italian Chardonnay made with no oak. This is very pure with a slightly honeyed and buttery finish.		
7 2009 Handmade Chenin Blanc, South Africa	4.75	18.95
Ripe fruit salad of a wine, totally delicious & de-vine. Aromatic with bags of flavour Drinking fantastically right now.		
8 2007 Macon-Solutre-Pouilly, Domaine Romanin, Bougogne, France		21.50
Great, creamy with melted Brie flavours. Sourced from around three villages.		
9 2007 Torrentes Blanco, Cinco tierras, Ruben Banfi Salta, Argentina		19.95
Torrentes is the only indigenous white grape variety of Argentina. Heady Floral aromas & tangy tropical fruit flavours. Dry perfumed and very fine.		
10 2008 Willandra Chardonnay, NSW, Australia		18.50
Organic unoaked wine made from gently pressed juice which avoids any of the bitterness associated with harshly crushed pips.		
11 2008 Bouchard Finlayson, Blanc de Mere, South Africa	5.25	19.75
Cool and classy blend with tons of flavour and really good balance.		
12 2007 Wakefield Riesling, Clare valley, Australia		20.00
A superb example of a dry Riesling from Clare valley. Lemony with a broad, fresh, vibrant palate and real complexity.		
13 2007 Gerwurtztraminer Reserve, Alsace, Turckheim, France		22.00
Ripe lychees and rose petals with lowish acidity. Fantastic value.		
14 2008 Eventide Viognier, Mischa Estate, Wellington, South africa		21.00
Medium bodied and full of ripe stone fruit with hints of citrus.		

15	2006 Saint Veran, les creches, Burgundy, France	24.50
	Bright yellow in colour with fabulous depth and intensity of flavour. Citrus tropical fruits with a hint of oak from the barrel fermentation. Rich and complex.	
16	2006 Soave Classico, Cantina Fillipi, Veneto, Italy	21.00
	A dry and intensely concentrated soave. This is a far cry from your average soave! Wonderful depth and complexity with finesse and elegance.	
17	2008 Albarino, Eidosela, Spain	22.00
	Fairly light-bodied, yet complex, peachy Albarinho, a bit like spanish Sancerre.	
18	2008 Sancerre, les boucauds, Claude Riffault, France	24.25
	A fine example of sancerre which is made from the sauvignon blanc grape. Flinty very fresh with minerality and crisp aromatic fruit.	
19	2008 Pouilly Fume, Domaine seguin, Loire, France	24.95
	Like the sancerre this is also entirely made with the sauvignon blanc grape. Terrific this is invitingly fresh, floral and aromatic and shows apple, green apple fruit	
20	2008 Kahurangi Estate, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand	22.00
	Passion fruit and soft kiwi dominate with some ripe honeydew on the finish.	
21	2007 Pouilly Fuisse, Burgundy, Domaine Romanin, France	26.50
	Big, bold and buttery. This is a barrel fermented oaked chardonnay.	
22	2003 Riesling Kabinett, Maiminn Grunhauser, Mosel, Germany	27.95
	A light and very complex off-dry riesling from the Ruwer, one of the top estates in Germany. This is very Cristaline pure with creamy honeyed mineral fruit.	
23	2007 Chablis 1er Cru, Fourchaume, A Boudin, Chablis, Burgundy, France	31.50
	Very fresh with intense flower notes characterising the aromatic complexity of this famous premier-cru. Great richness and good structure and a finish marked by fine mineral, stoney-fruit notes.	
24	2001 Mersault, Henri Boillot, Burgundy, France	49.00
	Medium gold colour, lovely enticing nose, fresh, high tones with hints of pineapple & pear. The sweet palate has really excellent balance, some fat and impressive length for the appellation. Great aromatic and buttery finish.	
25	2004 Puligny-Montrachet 1er cru, La Garenne, Vincent Escalier, France	52.00
	This is invitingly fresh, floral and aromatic and shows apple, green apple fruit with very well-integrated toasty oak. Already showing great complexity.	
26	2005 Condrieu, Laurent Tardieu	54.00
	Golden in colour, this is made from viognier and shows typical exotic fruits apricots, peaches and white flowers in abundance. Sweet on the nose, the palate is dry with aromatics and a fine minerality.

	A fruity, charming salmon coloured rose with a hint of spice and floral fruit.	
41	2008 Slowine Pinot Noir Rose, South Africa	16.95
	Lovely light-hued, light hearted Rose with strawberry and cherry aromas.	
43	2008 Sancerre Rose, Claude Riffault, La Noufe, France	26.95
	From 100% pinot noir this refined and elegant sancerre rose shows a nose of red fruits. The palate is refreshingly dry with a spicy and aromatic finish.
